Proposal: Application for variation of condition 1 (approved drawings) if planning consent 2304/23/VAR for change to house roof. Comment – The parish council object to this variation as the change to the degree of angle of the roof ridge height is disproportionate to neighbouring properties. The angle of the roof ridge has already been agreed and approved, and this variation would not make any difference to workings of the roof.

2. Reference: 3859/24/ARC – Approval if details reserved by conditions. Site Address: Woodside Cottage, Diptford, TQ9 7NQ. Proposal: application for approval of details reserved by condition 7 (Habitat Management and Monitoring Plan) of planning consent 1225/24/FUL. No consultation is required for this approval of details reserved by conditions.

3. Reference: 3953/24/PDM - Approval of details reserved by conditions. Site Address: Simpson Farm, Diptford, TQ9 7NF. Proposal: Application to determine if prior approval is required for a proposed change of use of agricultural buildings/barns to 5 NO dwelling house (class C3) & for associated developments (Class Q (a+b)) – The parish council is concerned about an issue over flooding at the entrance to the site, if works go ahead. The parish council has previously raised concerns of a blocked buddleholes and particular attention to drainage requirements.
